What IS FITT?

- An Intensive In-home crisis stabilization program partnering with Families to resolve crisis, prevent out of home placement, and provide skills for future crisis prevention
- Alternative for youth at risk of Hospitalization and RTC
- May also be utilized as a step-down service to better serve Youth needing an intense level of care as he/she returns home
- Serving Passport, Anthem, Humana, Aetna, and Wellcare Medicaid members in metro area



How Do We Do It?

- ⇒ A Masters level therapist and Family Peer Support Specialist will be assigned to the child and family
- ⇒ Visits are 5 to 7 times weekly in the home, depending on family need, and then 3 times weekly during the last two weeks- concentrating on transition and an active connection with aftercare Provider(s)
- \Rightarrow Actively partners with Schools, Courts, DCBS and Health Providers as needed
- \Rightarrow Expedited Access to Psychiatric care
- ⇒ Average LOS is 60 to 74 days and up to 100 days
 ⇒ A plan of care is developed with emphasis on safety and crisis planning, utilizing PSC, PSI, LOCUS, and CYRM assessments to guide treatment interventions
- ⇒ Hands on skills training for parents/caretakers in managing crisis and behavior incidents
- ⇒ Address safety concerns, offering physical security measures to ensure safety for all family members
- \Rightarrow Families have access to staff around the clock
